Ms. Power also represents an indigent death row inmate in his post-conviction petition for relief. During law school, Ms. Power competed in trial team competitions throughout the country. She twice received the award for best advocate in Pennsylvania and New Jersey and, in 2014, she was the national champion of the Top Gun National Mock Trial Competition.
